



Wedding Package-2012

The traditional Sri Lankan Wedding is performed on a decorated canopied dais (Poruwa). The bride and bridegroom are dressed in ceremonial Sri Lankan costumes. Jayamangala stanzas of blessings are sung by young girls. Dancers to the beating of drums make the ceremony colorful.

The ceremony can be tailor made to suite the couple. A list of options and the prices are given below. The minimum package should not be less than US\$ 1750.

The required documents for an official marriage in Sri Lanka are given below and each person should provide a duplicate copy of each of the following. These copies should be forwarded to the hotel two weeks prior to the date of marriage.

1. Birth certificate
2. Passports – copies are only required of the information pages, do not include the pages containing immigration and visa stamps.
3. A letter stating your full name, postal address and occupation.
4. A letter stating the full names, addresses and occupations of your parents.
5. An affidavit confirming your status

The following documents are required only if they apply to you.

6. If divorced – decree absolute(s)
7. Legal proof of any name changes by Deed Poll
8. If widowed a) Death certificate(s) of former spouse. b) Previous marriage certificate(s)
9. If adopted – legal forms
10. If any document provided is not in English, then a legally recognized translator must provide a translation.

You must travel to Sri Lanka with all the original documentation for your wedding at the hotel 3 days (*must cover 3 working days*) prior to the wedding in order to attend to all official formalities. We recommend a minimum of 2 nights stay after the wedding day to produce your album after you select your preferred photos.
